Whereas we be informed that many of the graymes that were sent to flashing
had well be returned some havinge horses, some none, these are by vertue
of his majestie's Commission to be and other's directed to require you, that you take
diligent search to be made, for all that are so returned, or shall returne. And
to take a note of how many have horses, and the Copy thereof, and how many
no horses, that you cause them to be apprehended, and brought in person to his
majestie's castle at Carlisle to remaine in ward untill his majestie's pleasure
be further therein knowne, and this our warrant shall be your sufficient discharge
in that behalf. Given under our hande the 7th of 8th moe 1605.

To Sir Henry Lough knight of the shire and Commander
of the prisoners, in his majestie's castle of Carlisle.

By vertue of his majestie's Commission to be and other's directed, these are to require
you, and not to be in the king's majestie's name to demand you, that you
returne the body of Wulfrim Grayme, together with the warrant, and him
safely keep in ward, within his majestie's castle at Carlisle, without baile, untill
he shall be delivred from thence by the due course of his majestie's lawes, whereof
if you fail not at your will, and this our warrant shall be your
sufficient discharge in that behalf. Given under our hande the 6th
of October 1605.
